### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**How much does it cost?** There is no cost to you.

#### Who conducts the weekend?

Each CRHP "team" is made up of a parish priest and men or women who have attended previous weekends. Each new team that is formed continues the renewal process by presenting the weekend to the next group of invitees.

#### What happens AFTER the weekend?

The weekend can be taken as a closed-end renewal experience with no further commitments. However, many participants choose to become members of the next team which has the opportunity to put on the next weekend.

## Will I have to talk in front of people?

No one is required to get up and speak. You may have the opportunity to get up and share your experiences, but you are not required to.

## What about Witnessing?

The team members, not the participants, give talks. You may choose to share (or not) your thoughts in the small group with other participants.

## Why does Assumption need CRHP?

Assumption Parish is calling all of its parishioners to renewal. CRHP is one way to develop a deeper relationship with the Lord and with other parishioners. Assumption, now more than ever, needs its parishioners to grow in their love for the Lord and their love for each other. "Building" our spirituality is the most important way that we can develop our parish into a vibrant and loving faith community.

## What is CRHP?
