

Youth Stock Fundraising Information

We are hosting a 70s themed party called Youth Stock on Saturday, Feb. 25. Tickets go on sale this week and pretty much all of the proceeds go towards anyone who sells tickets and/or works the event.

Essentially, when a ticket is sold or a donation acquired, the buyer must specify who sold them the ticket. Additionally, for any hour that is worked for the event itself, we will be logging it per person.

Once the profit line is established, we will divvy up the funds based on ticket sales and the hours worked and all the volunteers will have “accounts” that will hold funds that they may use for any youth program of their choosing.

For example, if you sell 10 tickets and work 2 hours of the event, and everyone else does the same, then everyone will get an equal share of the profit. But if others only sold 5 tickets and didn't work the event then you will obviously have a lot more in your account.

All funds earned towards your account can be used for any and all summer programs and if you earn more than you spend, it will roll over to the next year and next activity.

Also regarding fundraising, we have and will continue to offer other fundraising things that many people can do, on their own, to raise funds for their events.

- We will have sponsor letters created for each event that can be sent out to friends and family asking that funds be sent directly to the parish and placed in that youth's account.
- Rent-a-Delegate
 - This is essentially a work for hire program that allows parishioners who need a little extra help to ask us, we can send a youth over to assist with things like yard work, moving furniture, cleaning, etc. and the parishioners will pay the church for the service rendered, in the name of the youth who completed the work.
